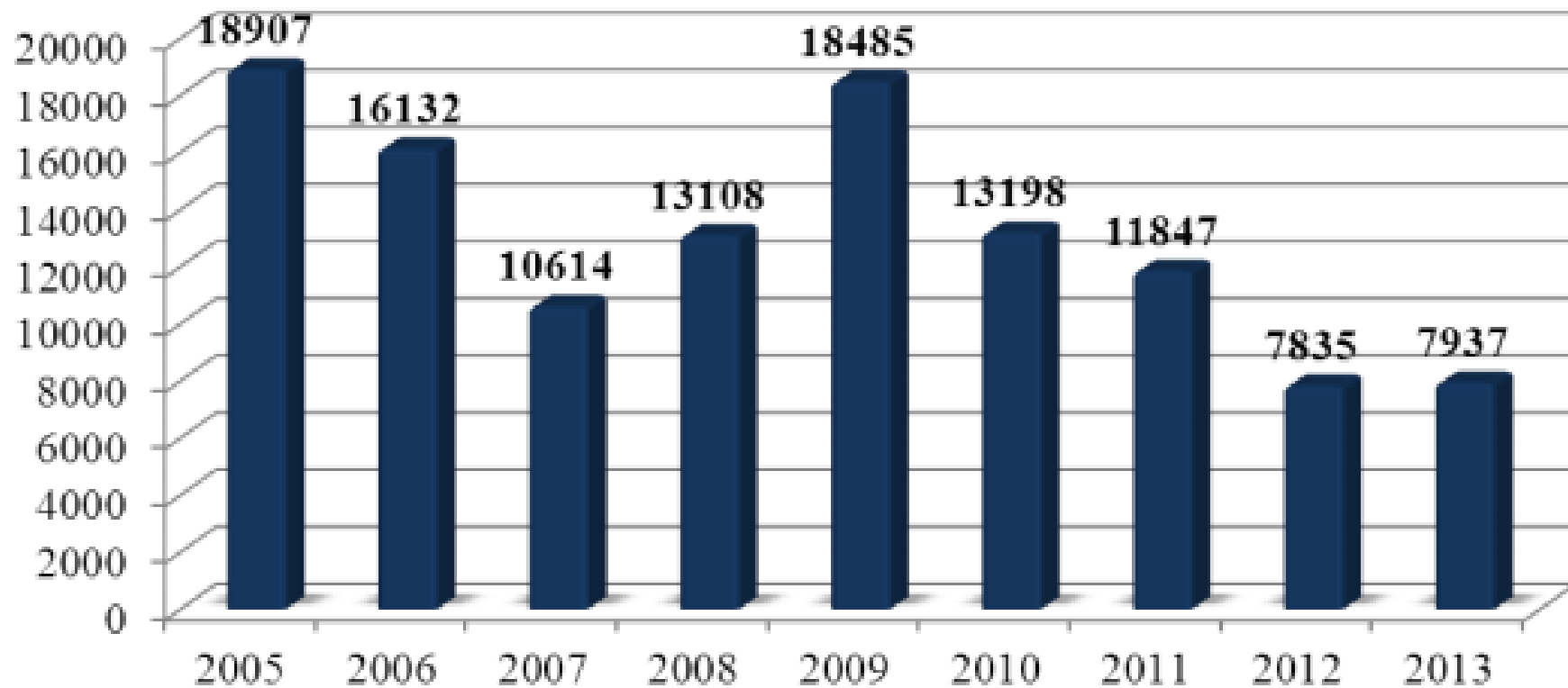

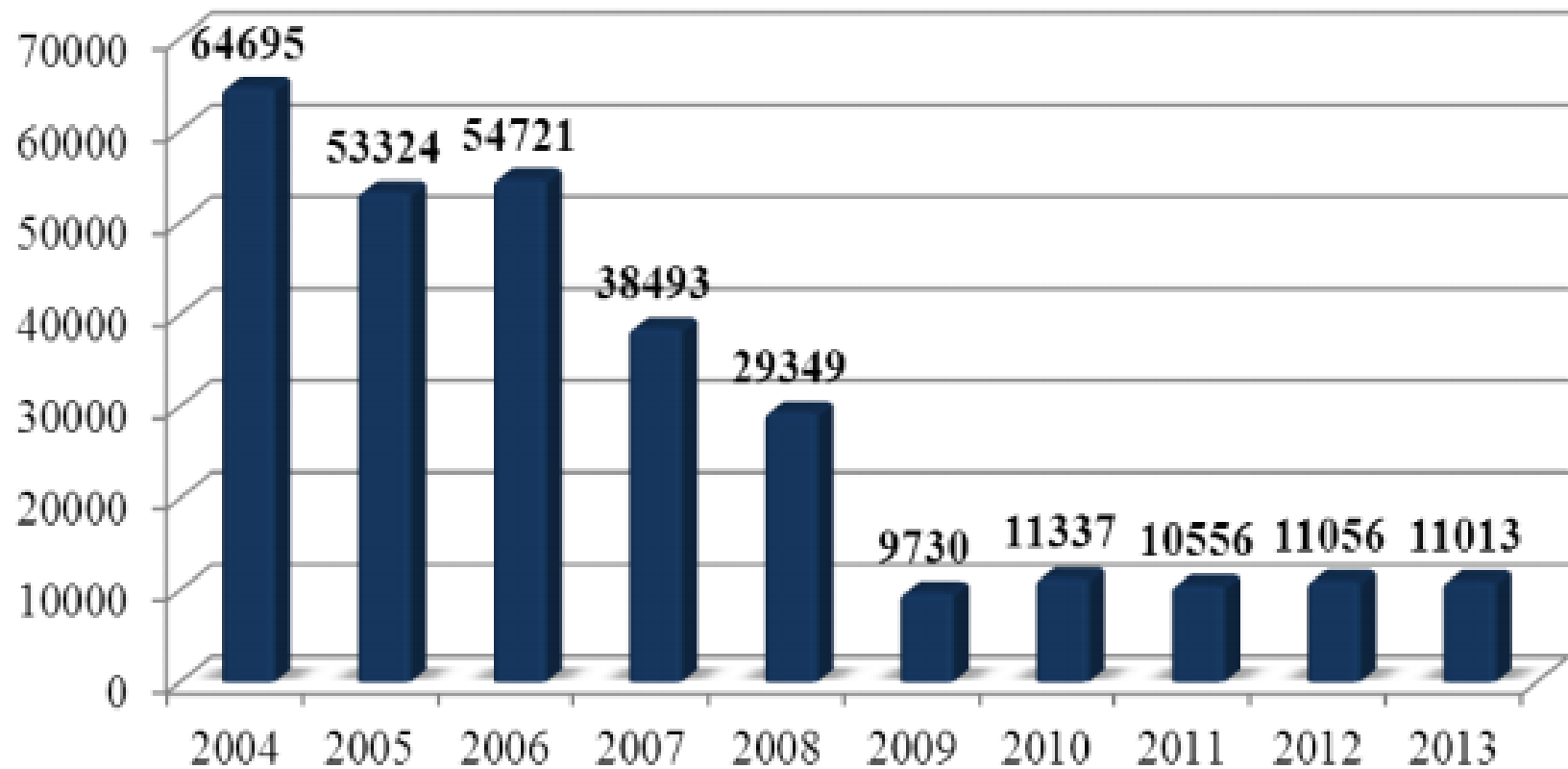

Number of issued individual work permits (2004-2013)

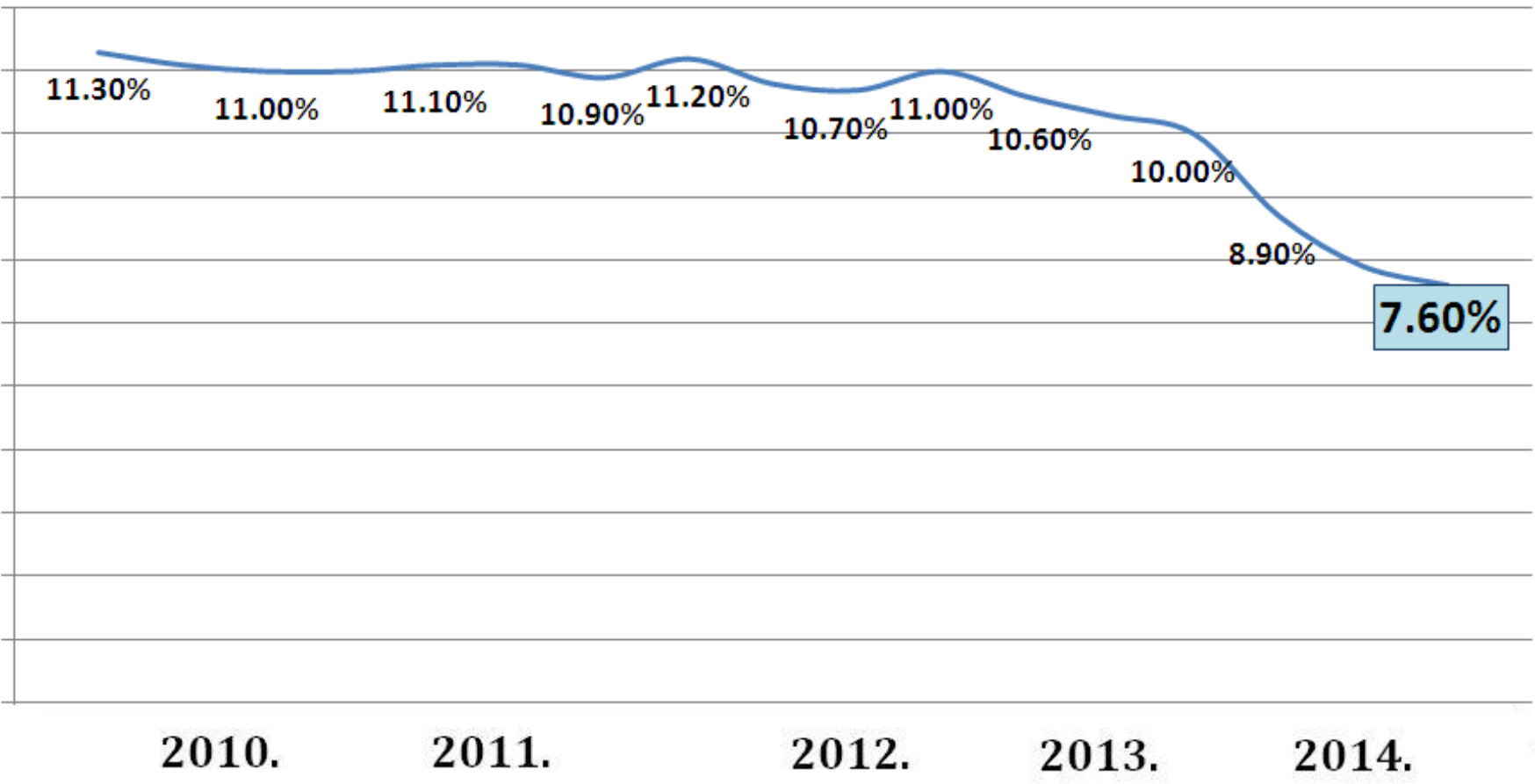

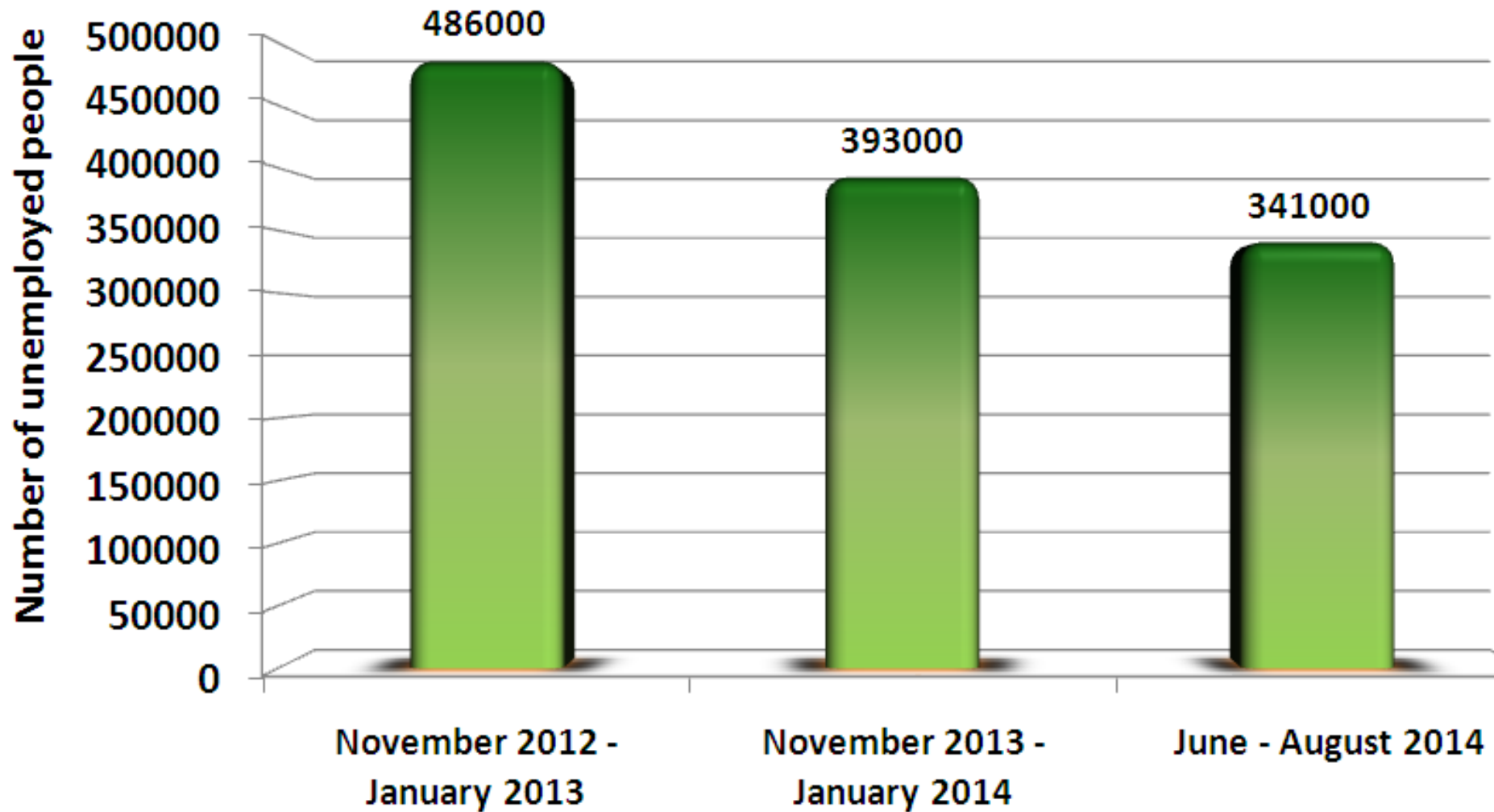
Statistics on unemployment and youth unemployment.



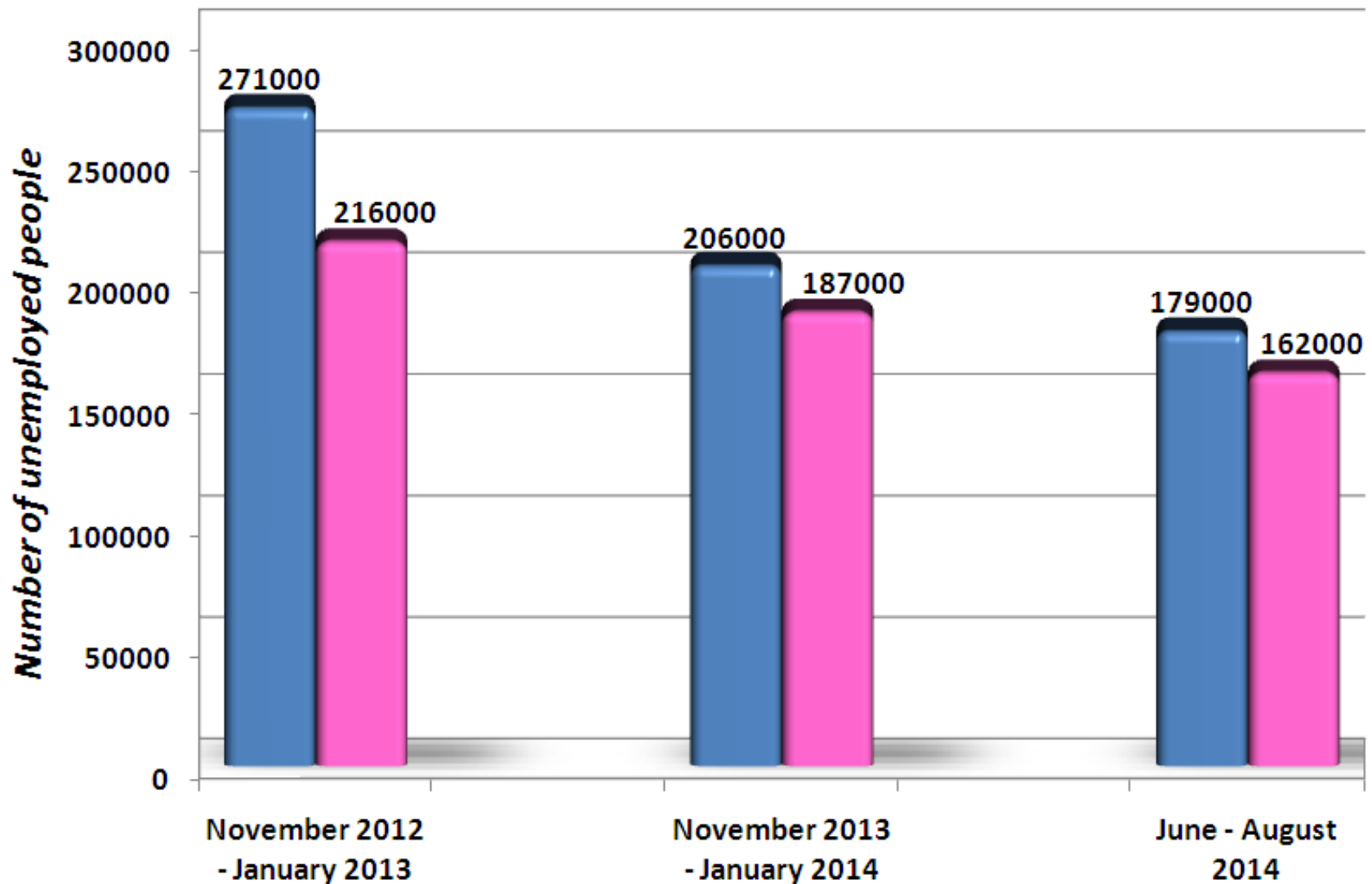
Unemployment rate in Hungary



Changes in unemployment in Hungary

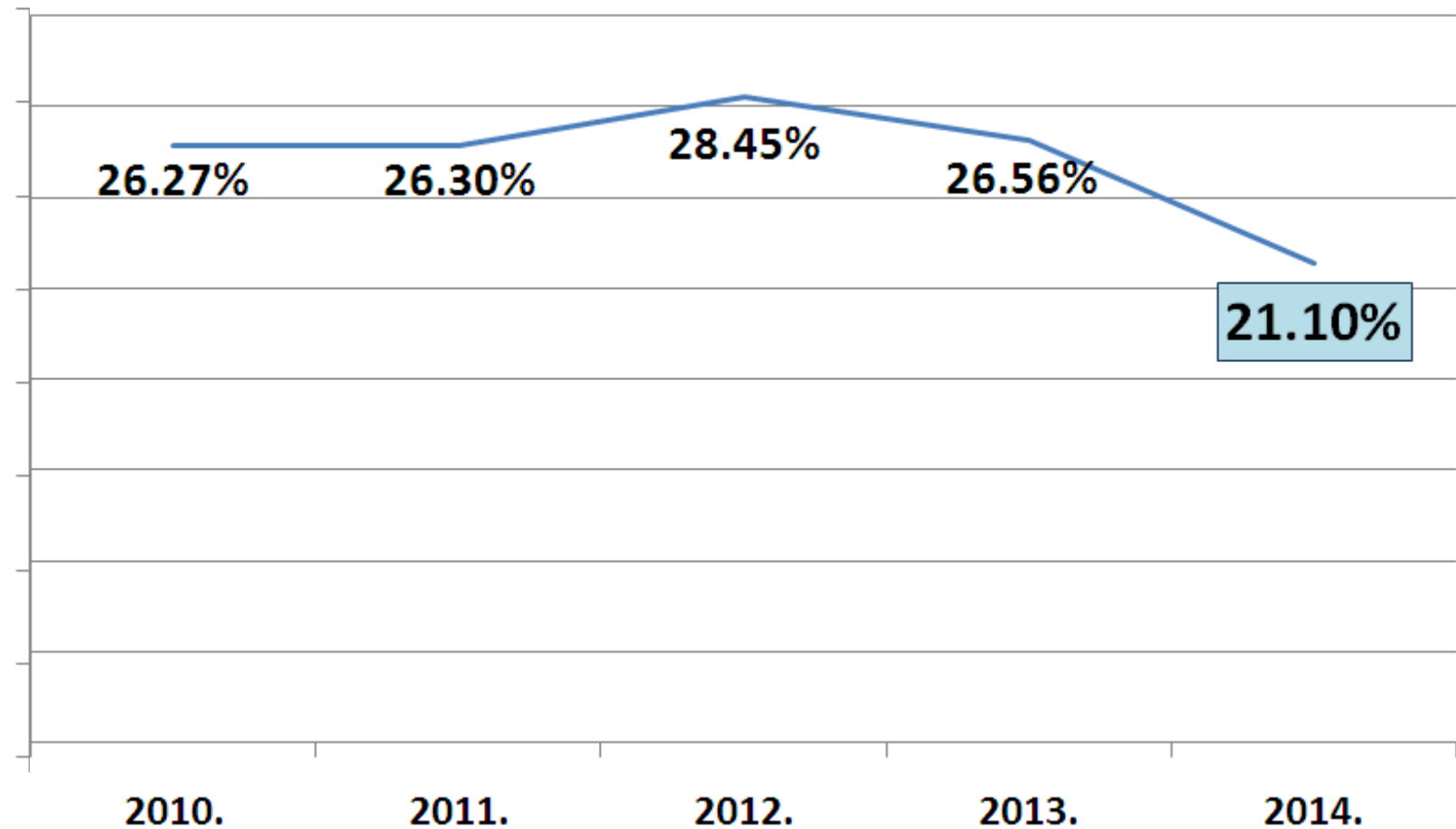


Distribution of the unemployed by gender

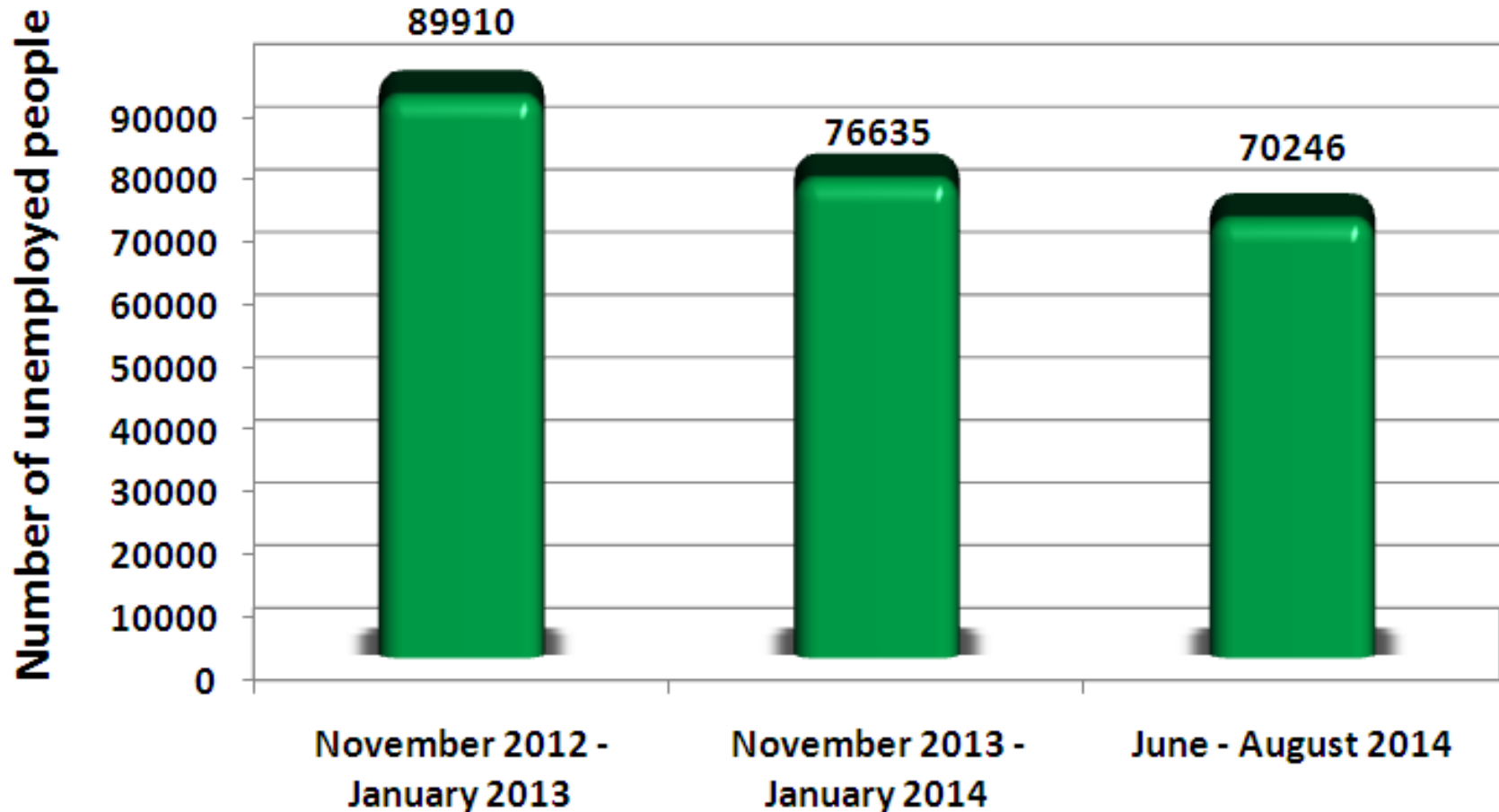




Youth unemployment rate in Hungary

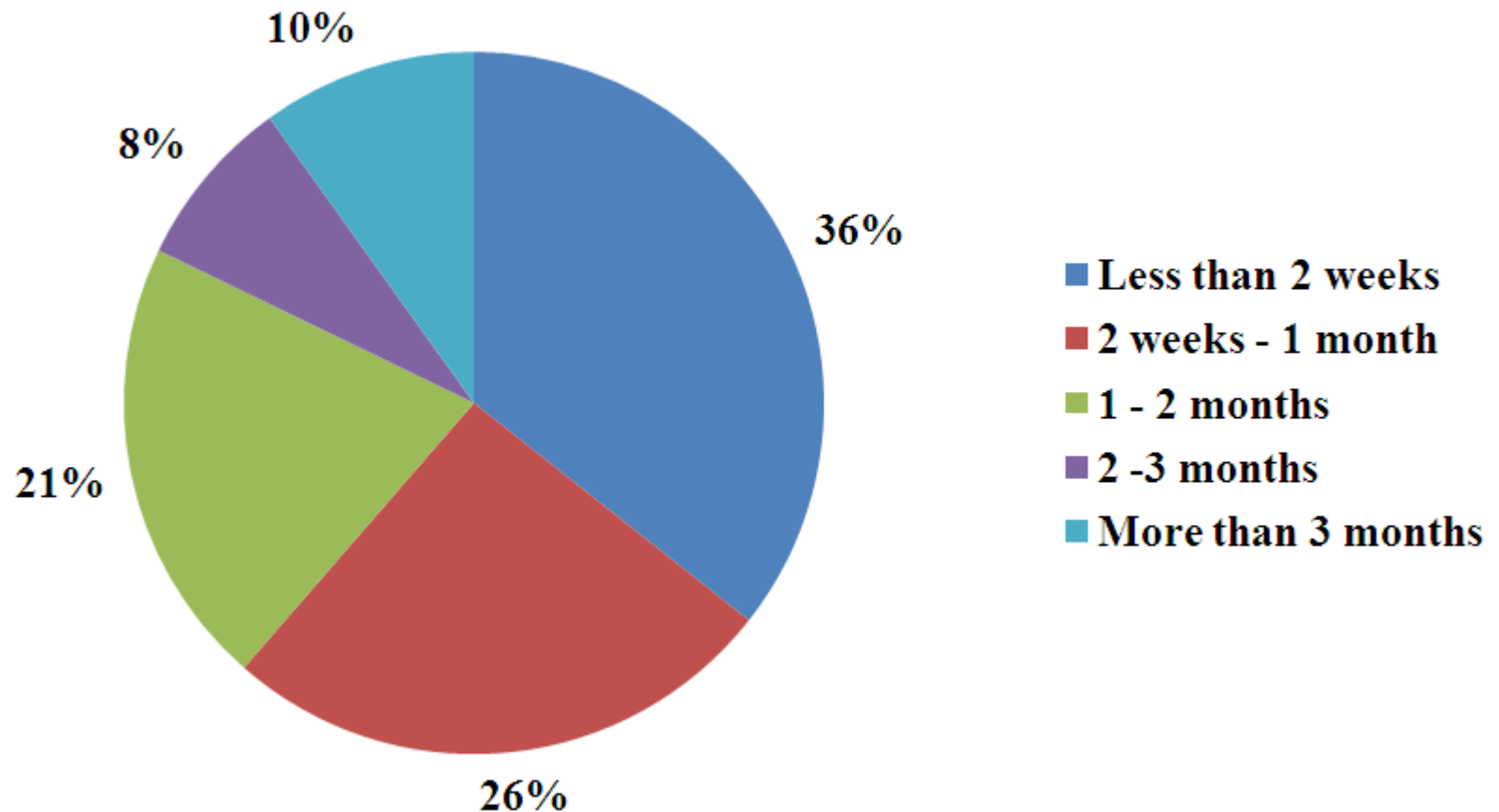


Unemployment between 15-25 of age



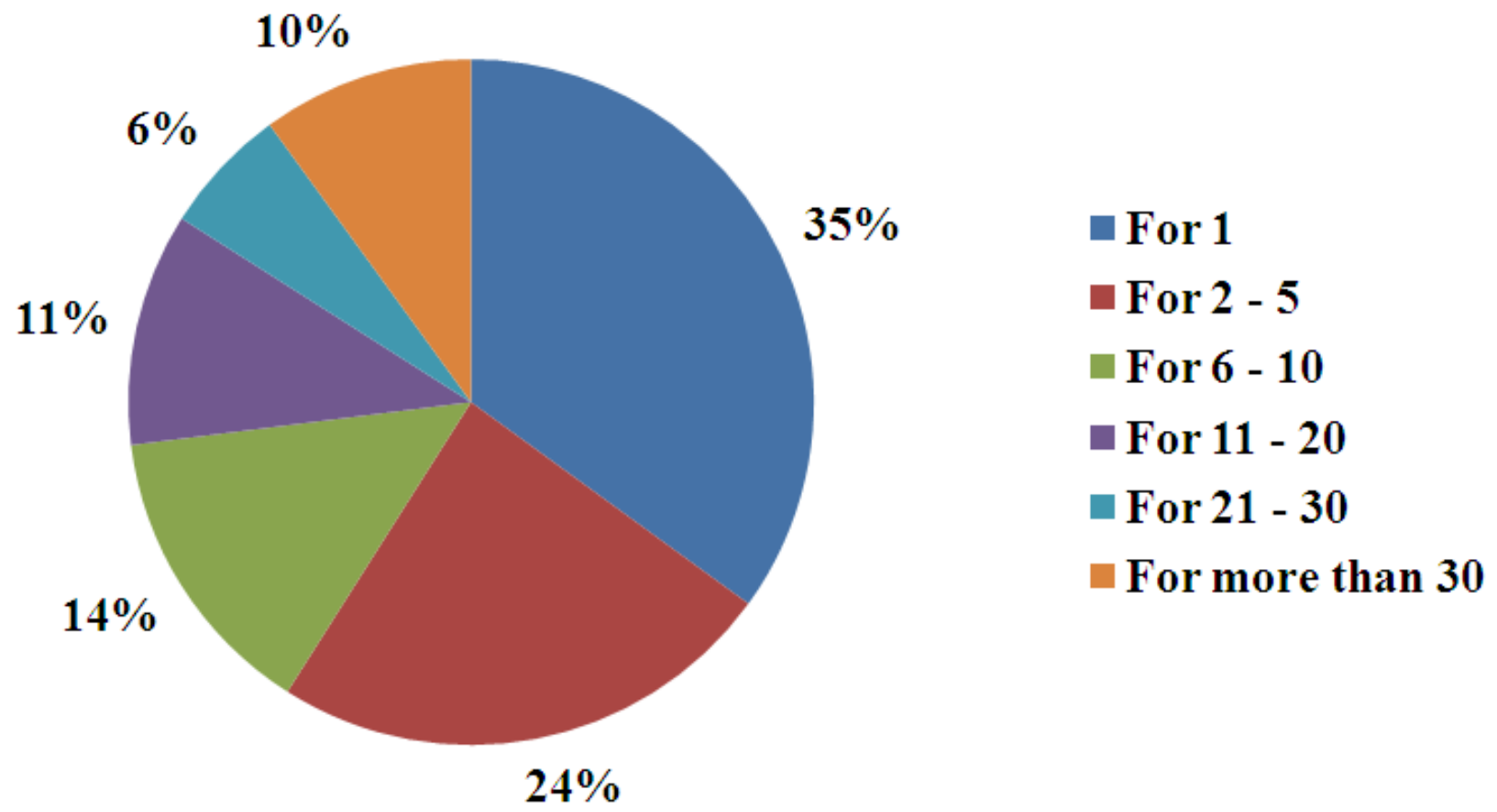

How much time did you spend trying to catch a trainee position?



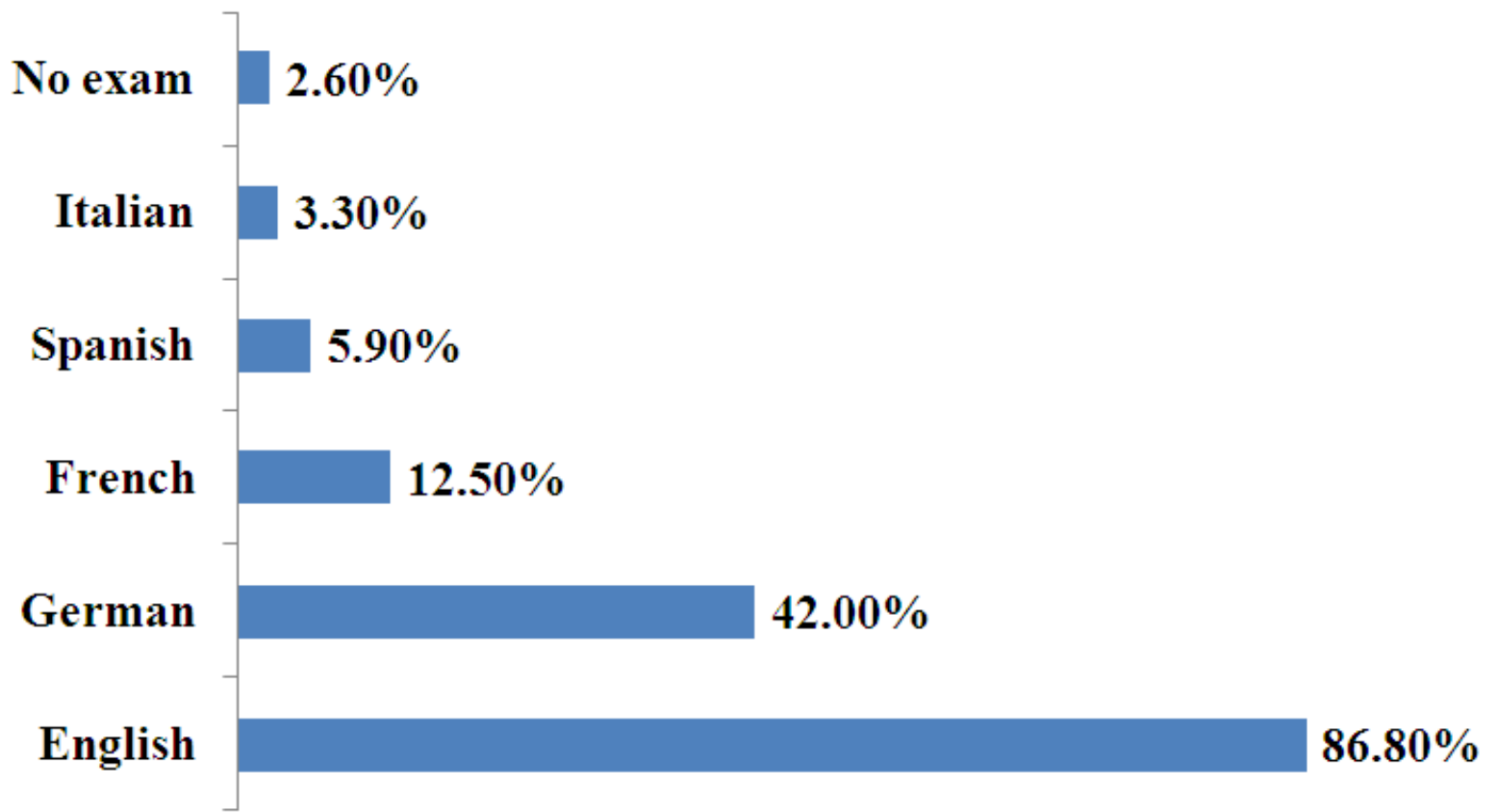


How many positions have you applied for?



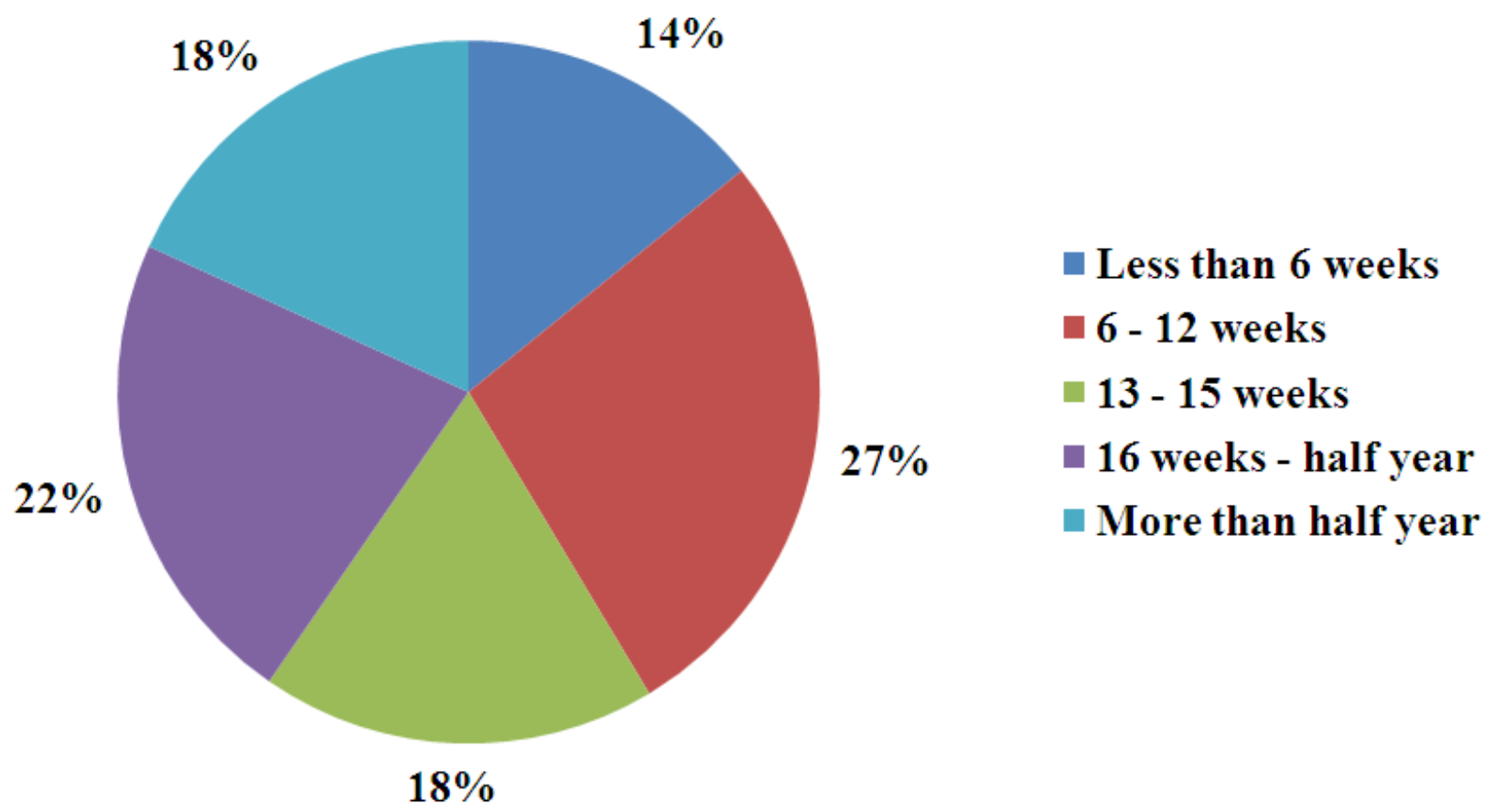


Which language exam did you pass?

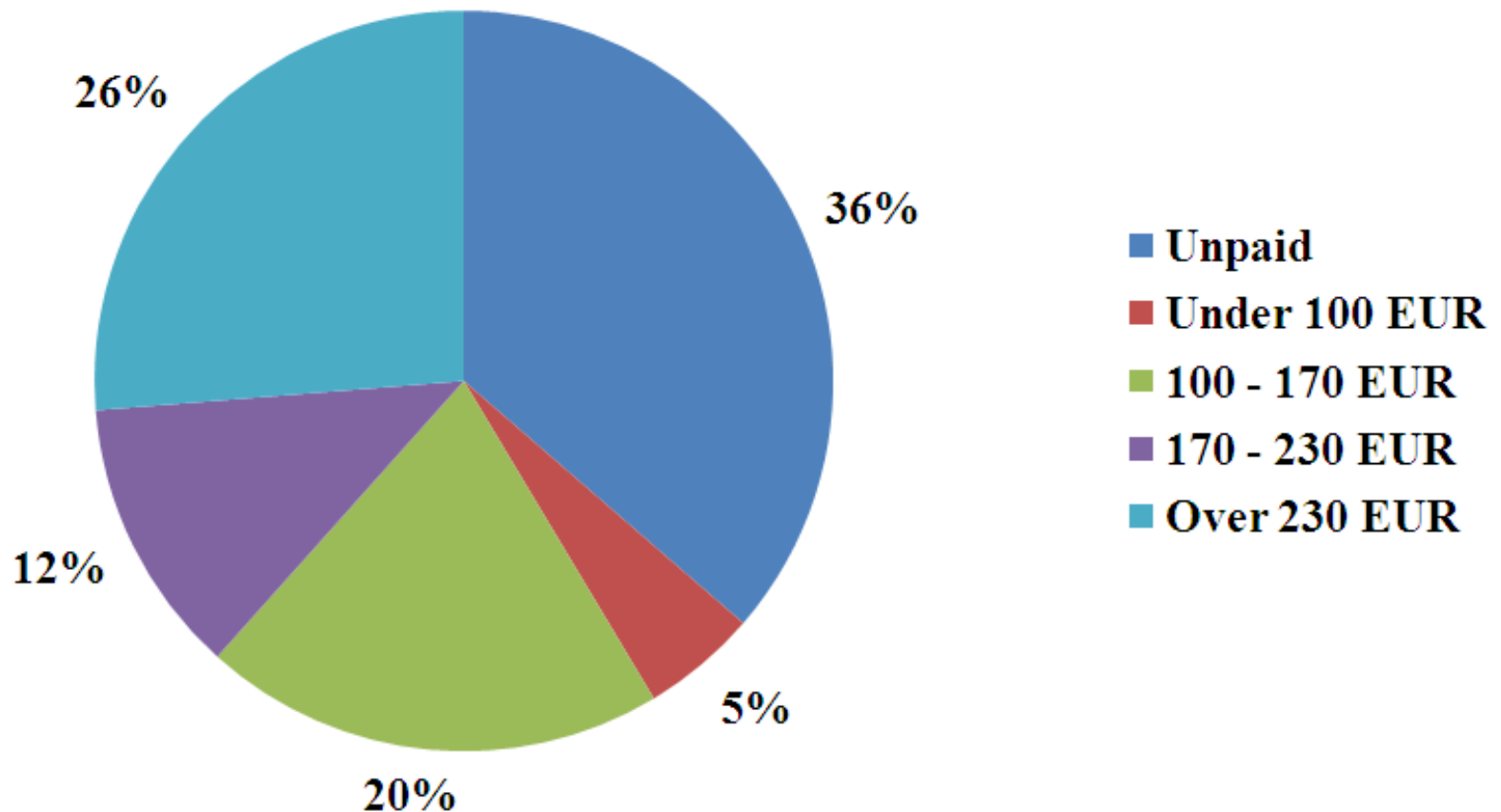




How long was the period of the internship?

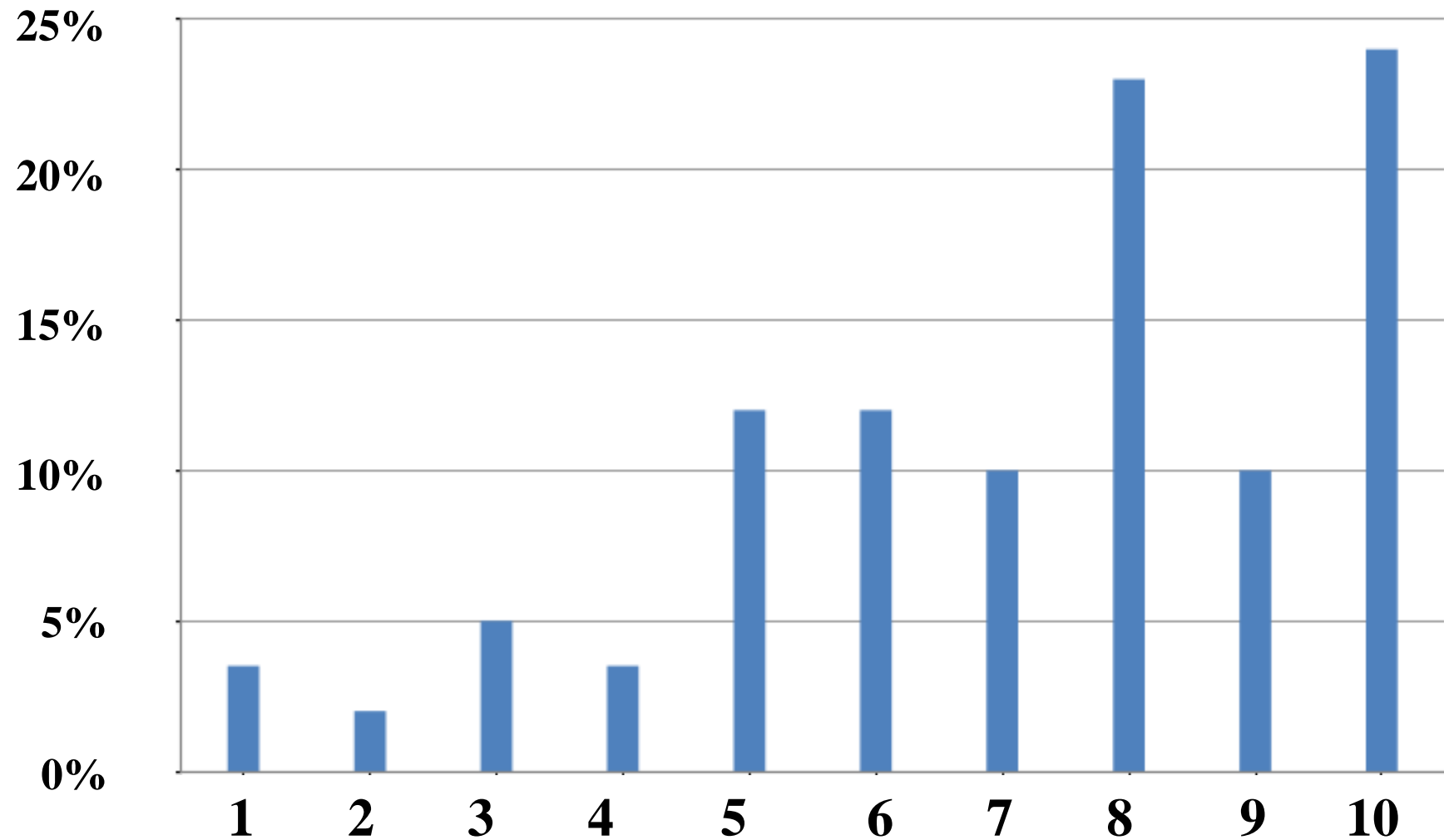


Did you get salary? How much?



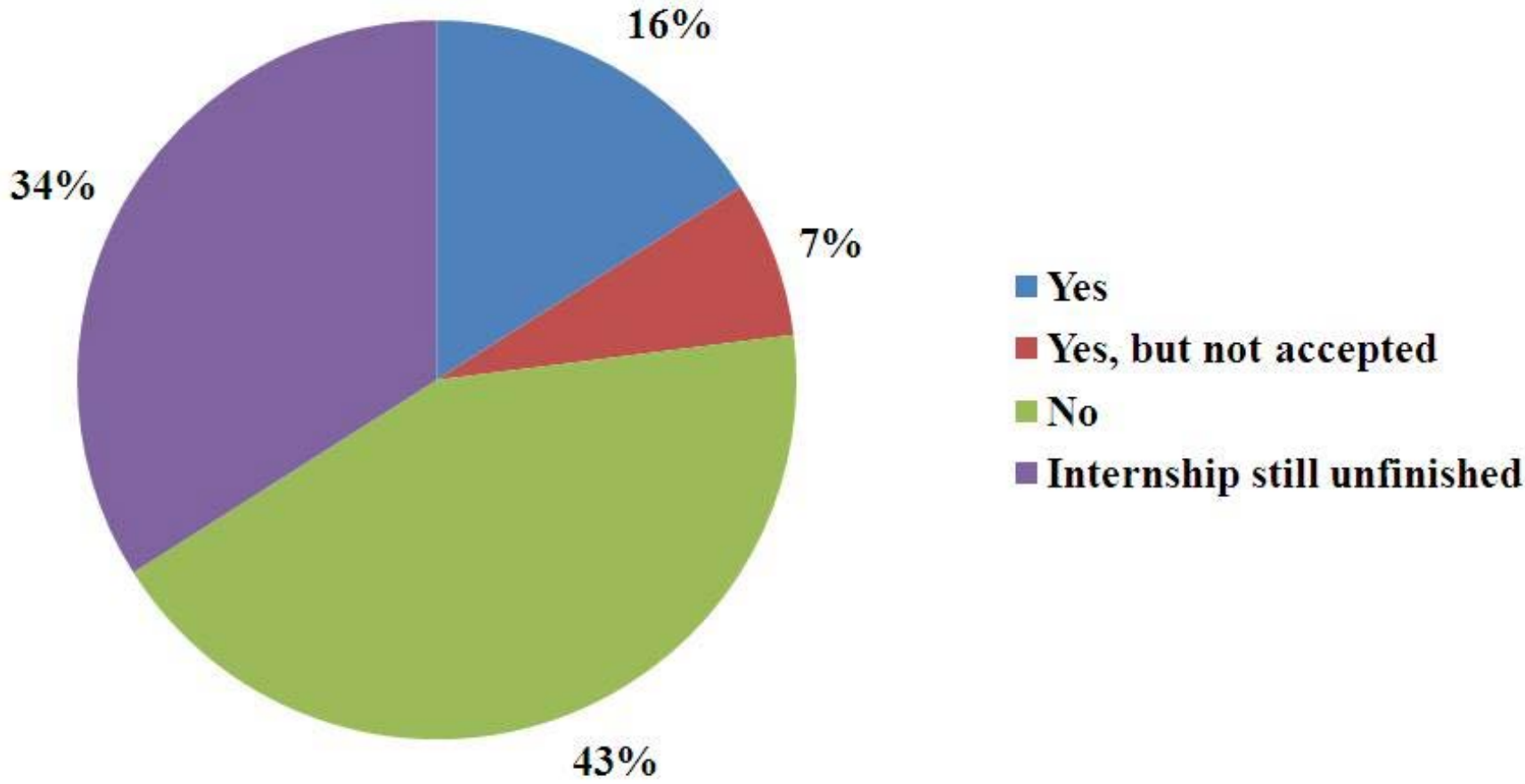


Was the internship useful? Rate it (1-10)!

Recognition of training from abroad

- ❖ Job → certificate must be recognized
- ❖ Process → according to the law
- ❖ Paper → level of your qualification
- ❖ Valid here → job
- ❖ MEIK, our higher education institutions

Recognition of training from abroad

- ❖ Rules of recognition → law (2001)
- ❖ Citizen of member of EU → controlled profession
- ❖ These are: education, culture, finance, agrarian, sport, national defense and justice
- ❖ Work in an uncontrolled profession → request the recognition at MEIK
- ❖ Need: original certificate...
- ❖ Finished → apply for a job

Minimum wage in Hungary

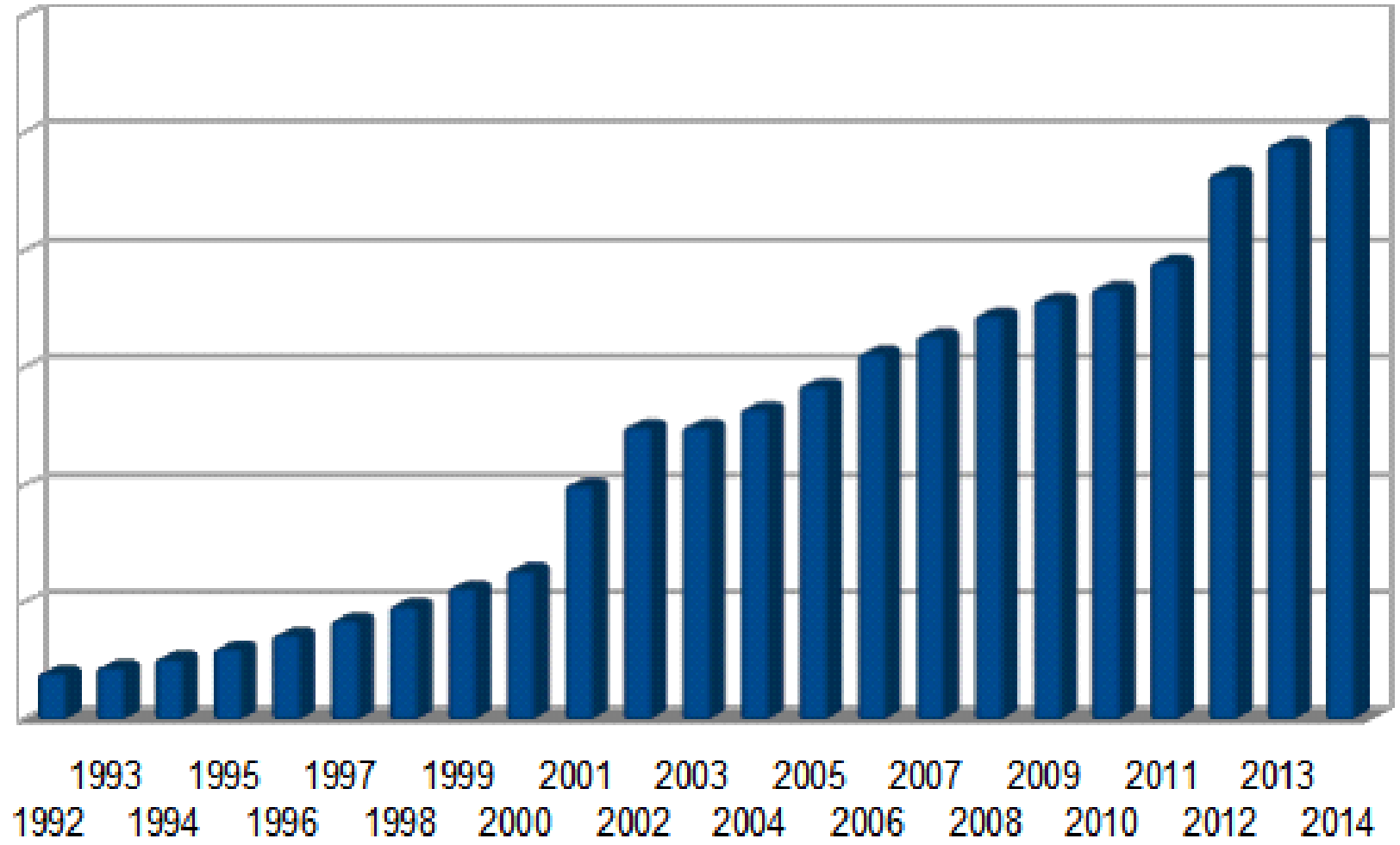
Lowest hourly/daily/weekly/monthly remuneration

Since 1st January 2014 minimum wage is:

- ❖ 1 month: 101.500 Ft (€ 321,8)
- ❖ 1 week: 23.600 Ft (€ 74)
- ❖ 1 day: 4.460 Ft (€ 14,8)
- ❖ 1 hour: 548 Ft (€ 1,7)
